

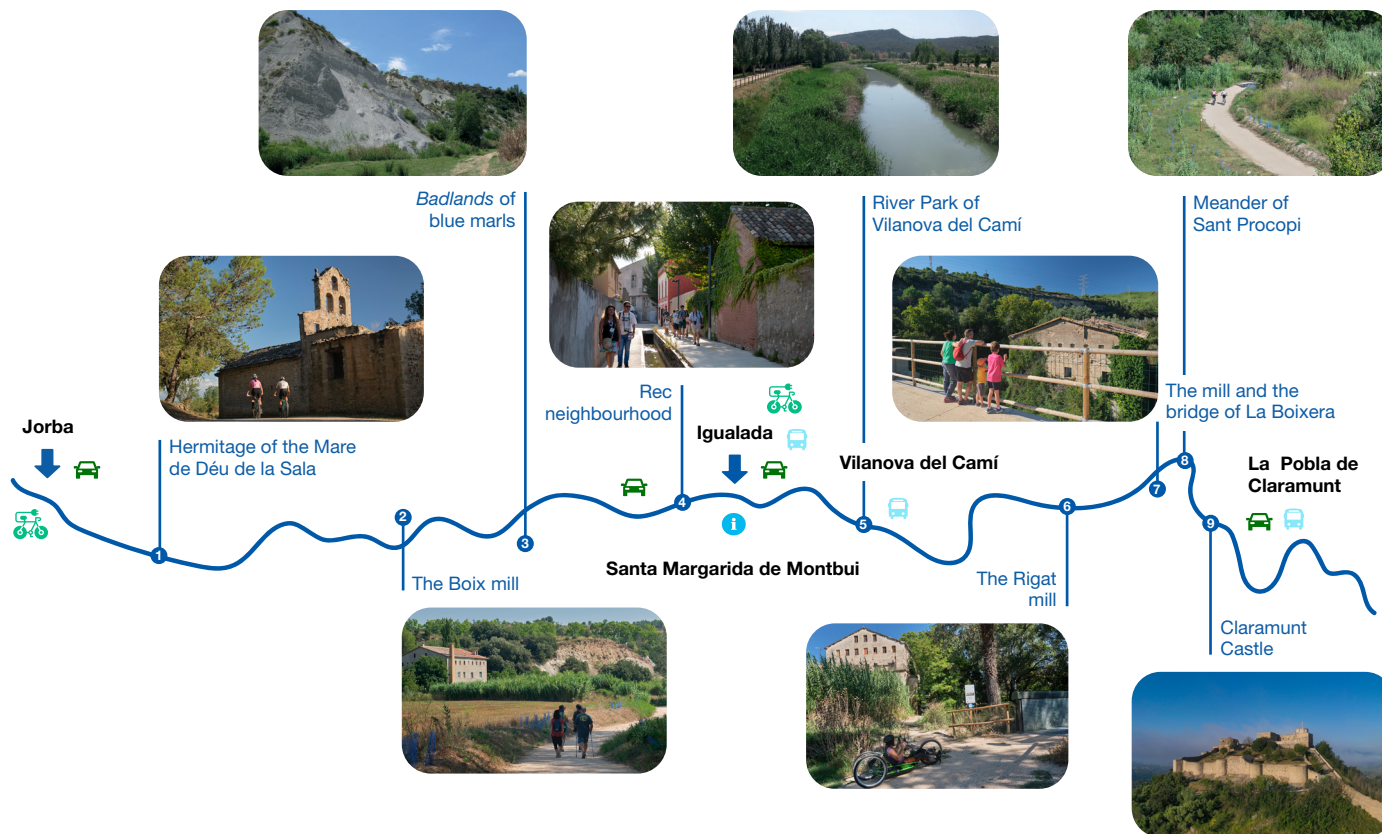
Via Blava Anoia

19 kilometres to enjoy nature on foot or by bicycle along the Anoia River.



The Via Blava Anoia is the first section of the Vies Blaves Barcelona network, a project covering more than 250 km of paths accessible on foot and by bicycle that will run alongside the Llobregat, Anoia and Cardener rivers.

Phase 1 connects the municipalities of Jorba and La Pobla de Claramunt along a 19 km route, **passing through natural, cultural and urban areas of great scenic and environmental value**. Enjoy sustainable mobility and contact with nature.



WHAT WILL YOU FIND ALONG THE WAY?

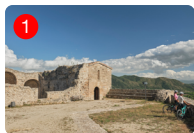
A tour full of points of interest that will surprise you:

- 1 **Hermitage of the Mare de Déu de la Sala.** A small Romanesque temple surrounded by nature, perfect for a stopover.
- 2 **The Boix mill.** An old mill located next to the river, a reminder of the area's industrial past.
- 3 **Badlands of blue marls.** Unique geological formations that give the landscape an almost lunar appearance.
- 4 **Rec neighbourhood.** Historic area with canals and old tanneries, now home to cultural venues.

- 5 **River Park of Vilanova del Camí.** Natural area with paths and green spaces ideal for walking and observing wildlife.
- 6 **The Rigat mill.** Traditional mill linked to the use of water for local industry.
- 7 **The mill and the bridge of La Boixera.** A winding stretch of river with a wealth of natural beauty and scenery.
- 8 **Meander of Sant Procopi.** River bend surrounded by vegetation and tranquillity.
- 9 **Claramunt Castle.** It stands on a hill and dominates the point where the Anoia river gorge descends into the Òdena basin.

Beyond the Via Blava, there are plenty of options to round off your experience: museums, castles, trails, pools and much more!



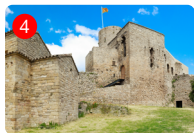

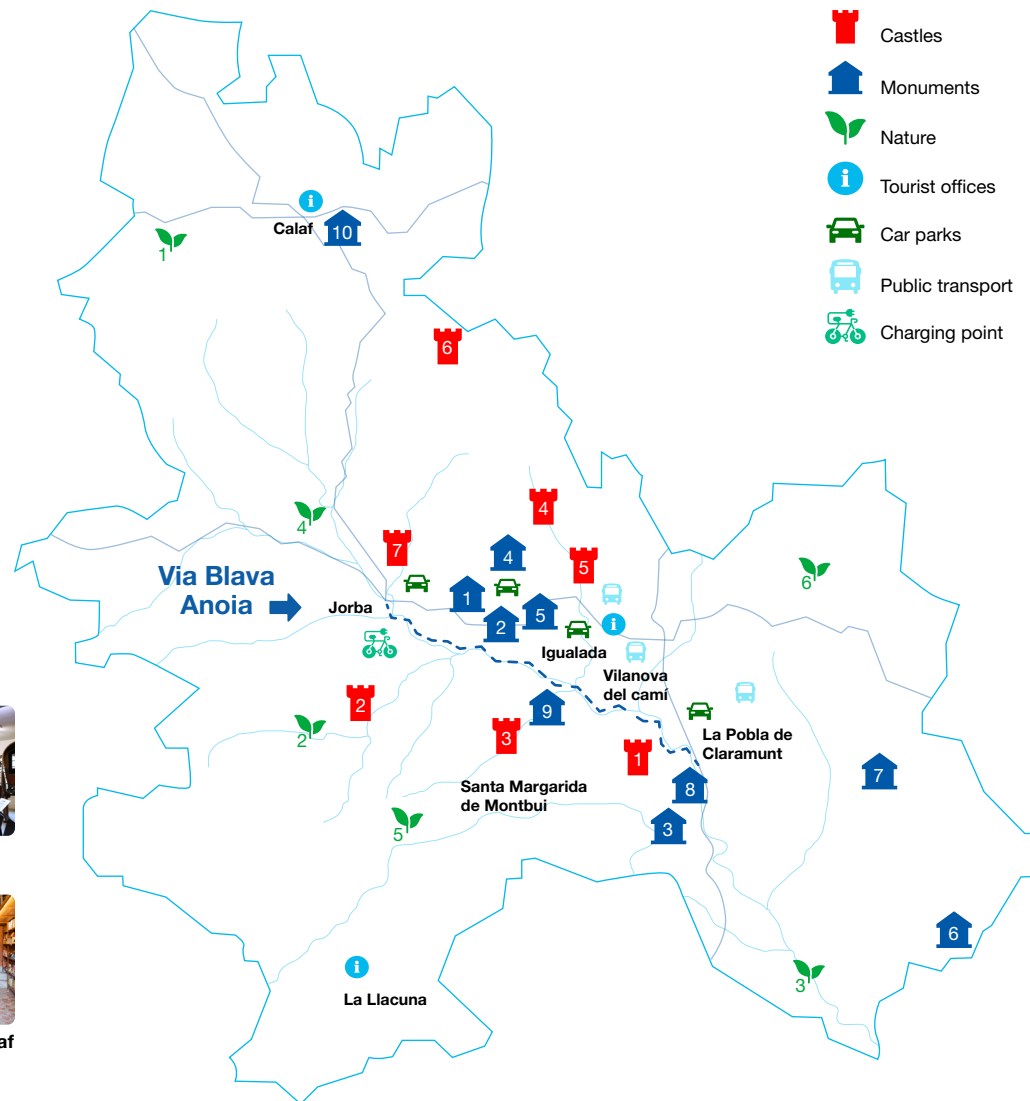
